

Contact Lens Policy

The charge for the contact lens fitting, initial and refits, must be prepaid at the time of your initial visit. All lenses must be paid for at time of pick-up, or they will not be released. Contacts not picked up within 30 days will be returned to the lab and a restocking charge of 20 % will be applied to the account.

Initial Fitting - \$250.00

(includes standard, disposable & planned replacements soft spherical lenses)

Initial Fitting - \$290.00

(includes mono vision, toric, bifocal & gas permeable hard lenses)

Refit - \$55.00 per visit

The above fees DO NOT include the supply of contact lenses.

Contact lens wear requires a "fitting" process whereby a patient's eye is measured, much like a custom suit or dress, and the lens is tailored to fit the individual's eye. This fitting also includes the teaching of proper lens care, handling and hygiene. In most instances this process is completed in 3 to 4 visits, although some patients may require more visits due to certain eye conditions. If more visits are necessary there will be a charge of \$35.00 for each additional visit.

If the fitting process is unable to be completed for unexpected reasons such as unable to insert or remove contact lenses, unable to keep scheduled appointments or unable to obtain satisfactory vision or comfort: a portion of the prepaid fee will be refunded. The refund will be calculated by a \$55.00 per office visit charge.
